

Timeline Checklist

This includes all of the information from the Greeting Memo, and some additional things to accomplish before coming to LKSOM!

June

- Make sure your [FAFSA](#) is submitted ASAP (should be done already)
- [Steps to receive loans](#)
 - Loan Entrance Counseling-**Required**
 - Master Promissory Note-**Required**
 - Direct Deposit-**Highly Suggested**
- Make sure your [email](#) is all set up! You will need to be logged in to your email in order to view some of the following links.
- Start reading *Whistling Vivaldi* by Claude Steele to be discussed during orientation
 - You can order the book from Amazon or just get it from a library; you do not need to bring the book with you to orientation if you have a good understanding, but you most certainly can!

- Send transcripts to Admissions Office. All transcripts from higher education must be sent. AMCAS does not share transcripts with medical schools. Transcripts are due by July 1. Transcripts can be sent

- **Make a Temporary Compliance Folder ([instructions here](#))**. This folder will house important forms you complete before orientation.

July

- Fill out the [Social Events Survey](#) by **Wednesday, July 26**. Filling out the survey is mandatory!
- Fill out [Orientation Questionnaire](#) by **Wednesday, July 5th**. You must log in to your Temple email account to complete the survey.
 - This form contains the following information:
 - White Coat Sizing
 - White Coat “Name Pronunciation” Question
 - Scrubs Order
 - Dietary Restrictions

- As for White Coat Ceremony tickets, each student will receive 4 tickets. These will be distributed during orientation week. We can accommodate your requests for more tickets at that time.
- Fill out the Matriculating Student Questionnaire (MSQ) from the AAMC
 - The AAMC should be emailing it to you, see [this document](#) for more information
- [Pennsylvania State Child Abuse History Clearance Form](#)
 - This process can be done quickly online (or via a paper form, but please allow 2-3 weeks for this method). When you receive your results, save a copy for your personal records and bring in a copy to be collected on **Monday, July 31st** during orientation.
- Health Forms, due by **July 31st**; they need to be mailed in so please complete as early as possible to give some time for processing.

 - [Immunization Record](#)
 - you are required to obtain titers as proof of your immunizations. Please include the lab copies of your titer results with t titers can be done for a cost of \$114.00.
 - If you are unable to obtain immunizations, you may schedule an appointment with student health **after orientation**.
 - If one of your titers is negative, you will need to get the vaccine or booster again, after which you will need to obtain titers again. You can do this at Student Health after orientation.
 - [Physical Form](#)
 - If you are unable to get a physical exam prior to arrival, appointments can be made at SHS, for a cost of \$26.00, after orientation; [Medical Release Form](#) (only if needed by your healthcare provider)
- [Safety Training](#) due by August 7, 2017 - before the first anatomy lab. You will need to bring a copy of your results to the first day of anatomy.
 - This training will **ONLY BE AVAILABLE FROM JULY 1-JULY 31**. Please do not enroll until July 1st. On July 31st, you will be automatically unenrolled from the Blackboard Course. Please complete all of the training modules before July 31st. Screenshot your results and:
 - **1. save a copy in your Temporary Compliance Folder**
 - **2. print out a copy of your results to be handed in on the first day of anatomy**
- Send in picture for [ID Card](#) (Owl Card) by **July 10, 2017**
 - **you must submit your photo in time for the OWL ID card if you want to sign up for parking in a garage/lot at LKSOM!!!!**
- Health forms due by July 31st (see above), remember that they need to be mailed in
- Read book for discussion during orientation week
- Check out the [“Student Resources”](#) Section of the SGA website for information about the Honor Code, the Student Handbook, health/well-being/counseling resources, etc.
- Purchase Netter’s Atlas of Human Anatomy if you see fit (See FAQ’s and Textbook Information for more information - there are no other supplies that you will need to purchase before school begins. This is not even mandatory, it is just highly recommended, but seriously, that means nothing else!)

- Complete the [SALT Online Financial Education](#) Module on Budgeting. Financial Aid is requiring that all incoming students take a quick online course in budgeting and finance managing before starting school in August. You will need to email financial services your completed certificate. Instructions can be found at the above link.
- Complete [Budgeting Assignment](#) if you are a loan borrower using this [excel sheet](#). Download the excel document to use it as a template.

August

- Health forms due **July 31st**.
- Be ready for Orientation **Monday, July 31st!** Remember, dress code for each day is **business casual**.
 - Bring a bag to carry some new gear!
- Bring a bathing suit, towel, change of clothes, and driver's license if you will be attending the **Tuesday** evening social event at Summit Park
- **Wednesday, August 2nd** bring a change of clothes if you will not be going home before the Alumni Association Bowling Social event that evening (although you will have about 2 hours in between)
- Invite your family to the SGA Welcome Barbecue on **Thursday, August 3rd** at 4pm.
- Remember the White Coat Ceremony is on **Friday, August 4th**. **You will need to be there by 9am, ceremony begins at 10am**.
 - You will receive 4 tickets on **Monday July 31st**, but be sure to give them to your family before you need to be there!
 - Dress is business professional.

- Health insurance is MANDATORY. Information about how to enroll / waive will be provided when school begins.
